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FUNDAMENTALS OF TRACKING IEP GOAL PROGRESS

Understand your child's goals.

2

Ask for your child's data.

If you don't understand something, ask!



— Reading Goal:

Present Level of Performance:

Given 5th grade material, Alex reads an average of 60 words per minute (WPM) with 8-10 errors.

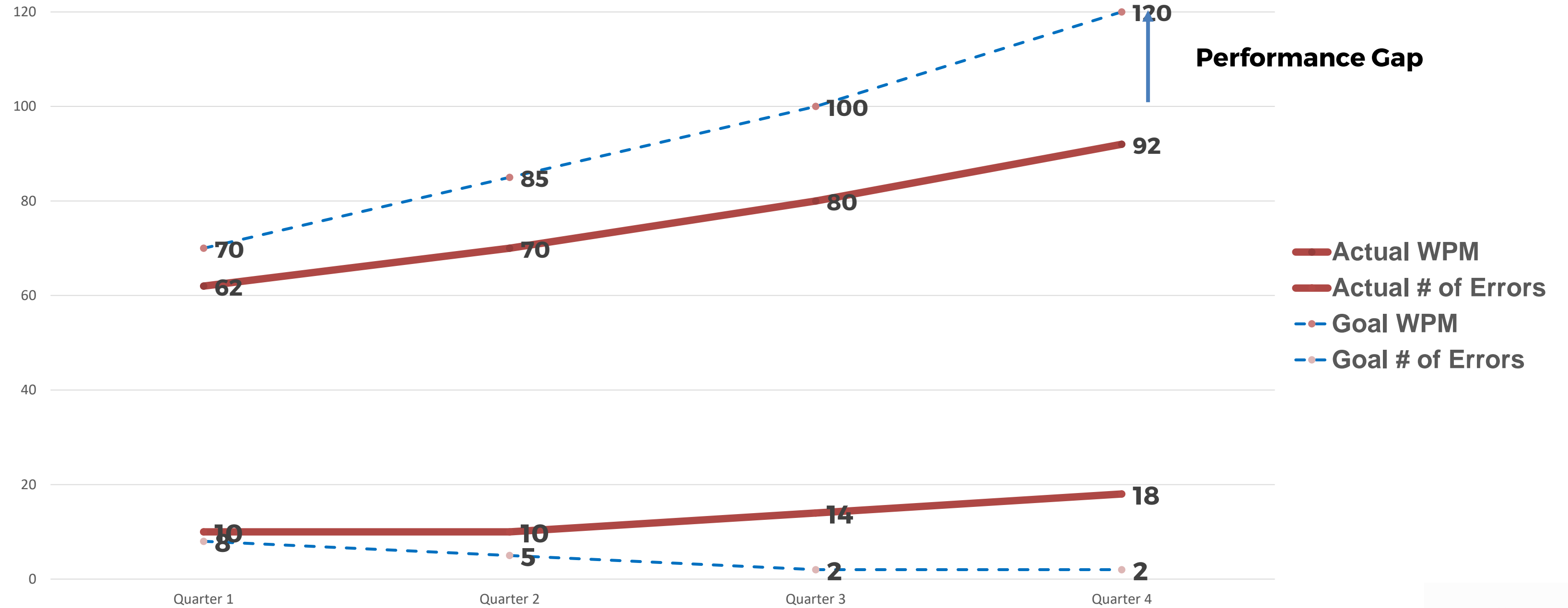
Annual Goal: Given 5th grade material, Alex will read 120 WPM with less than 3 errors. Progress will be measured at nine-week intervals (4 times during the school year).

- **Benchmark 1:** After 9 weeks, given 5th grade material, Alex will read **70 WPM** with **6-8 errors**.
- **Benchmark 2:** After 18 weeks, given 5th grade material, Alex will read **85 WPM** with **3-5 errors**.
- **Benchmark 3:** After 27 weeks, given 5th grade material, Alex will read **100 WPM** with less than **3 errors**.
- **Benchmark 4:** At the end of the year, given 5th grade material, Alex will read **120 WPM** with less than **3 errors**.
